(1b) Birtley's Problem 5.11b ★★
(1c) Undercling 5.7 ★★
(1d) Seam 5.11b ★★
(1e) Face problems 5.10+ ★★

- Tower One Area**
(4a) Substance Abuse 5.11a ★★
Thin face
(4b) Flak Crack 5.12a ★★
Flake to thin crack
(4c) Seams 5.10a ★★
Several thin seams
(4d) Tower One Face 5.7 ★
Low angle face, one bolt.

Sunday Afternoon Boulder

- (2a) Crack One 5.9 ★★
Hands to offwidth near top.
(2b) Crack Two 5.8 ★
This is the obvious wide dihedral to the left as you approach the boulder.
(2c) Crack Three 5.7 ★★
This is the crack just right of (2b). Great hand crack, crux near top.
(2d) Aids Victim 5.12a ★★
Very thin crack/seam

Train Boulder

- (3a) Scream Seam 5.11a
(3b) I Hear My Train A Comin' 5.12a ★★
Super good finger crack, crux start.
(3c) Razor's Edge 5.10d ★★
Powerful vertical liebacking on an excellent very sharp flake.

(cl. 1680ft)

Master's of the Universe

- (6a) Jump Start 5.10d ★★
Overhanging prow, requires a jump to get goin...
(6b) Arete 5.10c ★
Short face using the arête and edges.
(6c) He-Man 5.11a ★
Mantle
(6d) Skeletor 5.11d ★
(6e) Moroccan Menace 5.11d ★
Lieback/Arete

Elephant Area

- (7a) Elephant's Trunk 5.10a ★★
Hand crack
(7b) Elephant's Face 5.10d ★★
Face to the left of (7a)
(7c) Unknown 5.7 ★★
Face
(7d) Baby Elephant 5.8 ★★
Just like (7a) only smaller.
(7e) Baby Face 5.8 ★★
Just right of the crack.

Television Screen Area

- (8a) Chopper Mantles ★
There are a variety of different mantle problems on this flat top.
(8b) Super Edge 5.10b ★★
The right arête of the television screen. (A leaning-to-the-right variation goes at 5.11b.)
(8c) Woodward Arete 5.12c ★★
The left side arête of the screen.
(8d) Slant Crack 5.9 ★★

Dudley's Crack 5.11c ★

- Steep crack on West side of North Seminar boulder.
(13e) Left Long's Crack 5.10d ★★
The left of two right-leaning cracks found just North of the Seminar boulders.
(13f) Right Long's Crack 5.11d ★
The one on the right.
(13g) Hard as Nails 5.11b ★★
A dynamic start and thin tips gets you to the top.

Seminar Wall Area

- (13a) Seminar Wall 5.11c ★★
Follow knobs up the center of the wall until moving left midway to the arête and up. (Direct finish 5.12d)
(13b) Retropulsion 5.12b ★★
Follow the overhanging arête just right of (13a)
(13c) Corner 5.11d ★★
Follow edges up and left to a knob and a mantle on the South arete of the North Seminar boulder.

Soloflex Area

- (12a) Soloflex Mantle 5.10d ★
A difficult mantle on a very short rounded boulder with a slight hump on it's front side.
(12b) Korean Cowboy 5.12a ★★
Thin right leaning seam on a short smooth boulder.

Tower Two

- (9a) Chimney 5.8 ★
(9b) Crack 5.7 ★★
(9c) Face 5.10a ★★

Marshmallow Tower Area

- (10a) South Tower 5.10c ★★
This route starts on the block to the left, hand traverse right to the vertical hand crack and up.
(10b) North Tower 5.11c ★★
This is similar to (10a). Traverse left to the vertical crack and up.
(10c) Columbo Crack 5.11d ★★
Thin overhanging crack
(10d) Columbo South 5.10a ★★
Overhanging hands
(10e) Tricky Slab 5.11a ★

The Vomitorium

- (10f) Death Vomit 5.12b ★
(10g) Slabs 5.7 – 5.8 ★
Different variations exist on this low angle face

Control Tower

- (11a) East Face 5.10a ★★
Difficult start to finish in a thin crack at the top.
(11b) Northeast Arete 5.10a ★★
The obvious arête just right of (11a)
(11c) North Face 5.10c ★★
Thin face leading to a right leaning crack/flake
(11d) Seam 5.11a ★
Short hard seam

Painted Boulder Area

- (15a) Maria's Problem 5.11b ★★
Shallow crack facing the road.
(15b) Bobby Brown Arete 5.11a/b ★
Rounded arête with few edges.
(15c) Painted Boulder West 5.10b ★★
Face climbing to a horizontal undercling and up.
(15d) Painted Boulder East 5.8 ★★
(15e) Next to Painted Boulder 5.10a ★★
Good face/edges
(15f) Thin Faces 5.11a/c ★★
Variations on good thin edges

Robbin's Area

- (14a) The Spud 5.10b ★★
A dish problem.
(14b) Lie Detector 5.12c ★★
Thin tips and a super hard start.
(14c) Eric's Face 5.11a/b ★★
(14d) Robbin's Crack 5.10a ★★
A Woodson must do!
(14e) Triple Cracks 5.5 – 5.8 ★★
Excellent fun right off the road!
(14f) Don't rock the Boat 5.13a ★★
(14g) Pickpocket 5.10b ★★
Pockets & dishes
(14h) Driving South 5.12c ★★
Stout overhanging fingers.
(14i) Fissure Isabel 5.9 ★
Short crack directly on road
(14j) Hot Toddy 5.10d ★
Face

Blasted Boulder #2

- (22a) Left Face 5.10a ★★
Flat knobs and edges to the top
(22b) Center Face 5.11 ★★
Hard pulling through the broken center.
(22c) Right Face 5.9 ★
(5.11c variation – start right (22a), finger tip traverse left and head up 22a.)
(22d) Silk Banana 5.12c ★&%!
A crazy lookin' flake that requires some serious liebackin'.

Lemon Chiffon Area

- (21a) Face 5.10b ★
(21b) Bonnie's Bounce 5.10b ★★
Good edges on a steep face
(21c) Lemon Chiffon 5.11c ★★
Thin seam up a low angle face

Hellrazor Boulder

- (18a) Bob's Big Boy 5.9 ★
Offwidth to hands.
(18b) Hellrazor 5.12c ★★
Good edges on a steep face
(18c) Eric's Offwidth 5.9 ★★
Overhanging wide crack

Uncertainty Boulder

- (17a) Bozo No No 5.11d ★
Used as an approach to (17b). Usually aided by pulling on first bolt (5.7)
(17b) Uncertainty Principle 5.11d ★★
The ultimate Woodson testpiece. Start on the large block at the right side of the face and head straight up the wall.
(17c) Curtains for Certain 5.12a/b ★★
Same start as (17b) but traverse far left to a bolt and then up.
(17d) Big Nose 5.10d ★★
Face
(17e) Fly By Night 5.11d ★★
Follow the streak/face.
(17f) Mr Snoid 5.11b ★
Face

Gypsy Boulder

- (16a) Fallen Gypsy 5.12c ★★
Shallow dihedral/crack
(16b) Offwidth 5.8
(16c) Crack/edges 5.7
Cheat stones will get you started, climb into alcove, and up lieback crack at top.

San Diego's legendary Mt Woodson. Rock climbing & bouldering from the trailhead to the summit along the Eastside mountain road.
