- (40a) Grainstorm 5.12a ★★  
Steep overhanging edges  
(40b) Arch Crack 5.7 ★★★★★  
Super fun wide crack action!  
(40c) Big Man on Campus 5.11d ★★  
Steep start to a thin overhanging crack  
(40d) Rube Goldberg 5.11c ★★  
Overhanging flakes

**📍 Digit's Delight Area**

- (32a) Digit's Delight ★★★★★  
5.10d – Thin fingers.  
(32b) Camlock  
5.11c – Thin fingers, high start, cheat stones may be helpful.  
(32c) Fisticuffs ★  
5.8 – Hands/Fists, short & sweet

**📍 Airstream Area**

- (39a) Airstream 5.12a ★★★★★  
Thin seam on a low angle face.  
(39b) North Face 5.6  
(39c) South Arete 5.9 ★★★★★  
(39d) Turbulator 5.11a ★★★★★  
Short hard road side problem

**📍 Elsa's Area**

- (30a) Elsa's Crack 5.6 ★★★★★  
Unusually good low angle hand crack.  
(30b) Elsa's Face 5.10a  
Starts about 5 feet left of the wide crack and follows edges and knobs up a low angle face.  
(30c) Elsa's Lieback 5.8 ★★  
Lieback the right arête of the large chimney.  
(30d) Rick's Pick (aka Airplane Crack) 5.10c ★★★★★  
Excellent flakes to thin finger crack.  
(30e) Starving in Stereo 5.12a ★★★★★  
Beautiful right leaning finger Crack.

**📍 Mother Superior Area**

- (31a) Mother Superior 5.11d ★★★★★  
Awesome wide offwidth crack to “Y” shaped cracks near top  
(31b) Unknown Face 5.10d ★★  
Over hanging face just left of the crevice chock stones.  
(31c) Double Scoop 5.10b ★★  
Right along the road, a thin seam and two mantels.

**(38a) The Chrome Dome**

- 5.6 – 5.9 There are a good variety of bumpy Slab climbs here

**📍 The Cave Area**

- (33a) Manuel's Horror ★★★★★  
5.10a/b – Hands/Fists  
(33b) Greg's Crack ★★  
5.11c/d – Body pumping offwidth  
(33c) John's Crack ★★ 5.9  
(33d) Walking On Air ★★  
5.11b - Face  
(33e) The Cave ★★★★★  
5.11a – Overhanging jugs to steep face and crack.  
(33f) Obsession ★★★★★  
5.12c – Starts just left of the Cave, follows the left leaning arch higher up.  
(33g) The Bat Flake ★★  
5.10c – Obvious large flake/crack at West end of formation.

**📍 Alcoa Boulder**

- (34a) Stairway to Heaven ★★★★★  
5.12a – Steep edges, center of face.  
(34b) Alcoa ★★★★★  
5.11d – Right side of wall, follows arête.


**📍 Big Horn**

- (36a) Big Horn ★★★★★  
5.8 – This boulder is chock full of fun. Traverses, sit starts, jugs and more.

- (37a) Left ★★  
5.11c/d  
(37b) Center ★★  
5.11a  
(37c) Right ★★  
5.11a

**📍 Hamburger Area**

- (28a) Right of the Tree 5.8 ★★  
Sharp holds on a broken face.  
(28b) Left of the Tree 5.10a  
(28c) John's Nose 5.8 ★★  
A jug and a mantle on the prow of this large boulder.  
(28d) Hamburger Crack 5.9 ★★★★★  
Short fun hand crack. Turns your hands to hamburger.  
(28e) Baby Edge 5.7 ★  
Sharp left leaning arête (TR)  
(28f) Deadman's Party 5.11b ★★  
Thin broken crack up the center face of boulder  
(28g) Blasted Boulder #3 5.7-5.11 ★★  
Several different variations exist on this fractured test piece.  
(28h) Cast of a Thousand Stones 5.11c ★★  
On the East side of this boulder. A rust colored stain and right leaning finger crack across a very smooth face.  
(28i) Zippy Crack 5.11a ★★

**📍 Eppulator Area**

- (26a) The Eppulator 5.12c ★★  
Prominent dike on West face.  
(26b) Unknown 5.13a ★★  
Start at left arête and follow steep edges right for a big move to the top.  
(26c) Shawn's Knobs 5.10b ★★★★★  
Steep edges/knobs right of arête.  
(26d) Karl's Error 5.10d ★★  
Inside steep/overhanging dihedral.

**📍 Grand Central Station**

- (19a) Widow's Bereft 5.12a ★★★★★  
Overhanging thin fingers.  
(19b) South Crack 5.9 ★★★★★  
Excellent splitter crack  
(19c) North Crack 5.9 ★★  
Another excellent splitter

**📍 Manuel's Climbs**

- (20a) Manuel's Climbs 5.10b ★★★★★  
Excellent face on unusually good Woodson stone.  
(20b) Seam 5.10c ★★★★★  
Super good, 'nough said...

**(27a) Rockwork Orange 5.10a ★★★★★**

You have arrived! It doesn't get any better...

**📍 Poison Oak Area**

- (29a) Monkey Crack 5.10c ★★★★★  
Curvy hand/fist crack. Visible from road.  
(29b) Eppy Birthday 5.11a ★★  
An undercling, a flake, and up and away. Starts just right of Slap You Silly.  
(29c) Slap You Silly 5.12b ★★★★★  
That's right... the blank looking very rounded corner, you're in the right place.  
(29d) Go With the Flow 5.11d ★★★★★  
Knobby face with rust colored water stain on right. High start.  
(29e) Big Grunt 5.10 ★★  
The obvious large chimney. Have at it...  
(29f) Hairdo 5.12c ★★★★★  
Up the left side of wall.  
(29g) Cool Jerk 5.12c ★★★★★  
Follows the curving ledge right and then bolts up the center of face.  
(29h) High on the Hog 5.12b ★★  
Same start as Cool Jerk but follows bolts out right.  
(29i) Poison Oak Crack 5.7 ★★★★★  
Hand/fist. Located right on road. Can't miss it.  
(29j) Werner's Wish 5.11b ★★★★★  
Just down hill from (29i). Finger tips traverse right, around corner and up crack to top.

**📍 Perfect Slab Area**

- (25a) The Perfect Slab 5.7 ★★★★★  
Obvious slab. Try it no hands!  
(25b) Left Leaning Lieback 5.9 ★★★★★  
Super fun!  
(25c) East Face 5.10a ★  
(25d) Southeast Face 5.9 ★★  
Knobs/edges  
(25e) Mighty Edge 5.11d ★★★★★  
Right side arête on a beautiful square bolder.

**📍 Jaws Area**

- (24a) Corn Flake 5.7 ★★★★★  
Sharp flake/lieback (TR)  
(24b) I Would Die For You 5.12d  
Thin seam  
(24c) Jaws 5.11b ★★★★★  
Thin finger crack, located in a wedge.  
(24d) Baby Robbin's Crack 5.9 ★★★★★  
Super fun hands!  
(24e) Girls Climb 5.10d ★★★★★  
Broken flakes lead to a thin crack.  
(24f) Ballet Arete 5.11a ★★  
Very fun arête with interesting feet.  
(24g) Big Ugly 5.9 ★★★★★  
Face climb through big broken flakes  
(24h) Grab-n-Go 5.10a ★★★★★  
Fun face  
(24i) Barney Rubble 5.12a ★  
Face/Arête

**📍 Welcome Home Area**

- (23a) California Night 5.11b ★★  
Steep fingers up solid rock.  
(23b) Welcome Home 5.12c ★★★★★  
Vertical, thin... very thin.  
(23c) Unknown Arete  
If you found Welcome Home, turn around to see a steep sharp arête.  
(23d) Robbin's Area  
(14a) The Spud 5.10b ★★  
A dish problem.  
(14b) Lie Detector 5.12c ★★★★★  
Thin tips and a super hard start.  
(14c) Eric's Face 5.11a/b ★★★★★  
(14d) Robbin's Crack 5.10a ★★★★★  
A Woodson must do!  
(14e) Triple Cracks 5.5 – 5.8 ★★★★★  
Excellent fun right off the road!  
(14f) Don't rock the Boat 5.13a ★★  
(14g) Pickpocket 5.10b ★★  
Pockets & dishes  
(14h) Driving South 5.12c ★★★★★  
Stout overhanging fingers.  
(14i) Fissure Isabel 5.9 ★  
Short crack directly on road

**📍 Blasted Boulder #2**

- (22a) Left Face 5.10a ★★★★★  
Flat knobs and edges to the top  
(22b) Center Face 5.11 ★★  
Hard pulling through the broken center.  
(22c) Right Face 5.9 ★  
(5.11c variation – start right (22a), finger tip traverse left and head up 22a.)  
(22d) Silk Banana 5.12c ★&%!  
A crazy lookin' flake that requires some serious liebackin'.

**📍 Lemon Chiffon Area**

- (21a) Face 5.10b ★  
(21b) Bonnie's Bounce 5.10b ★★  
Good edges on a steep face  
(21c) Lemon Chiffon 5.11c ★★★★★  
Thin seam up a low angle face

**📍 Hellrazor Boulder**

- (18a) Bob's Big Boy 5.9 ★  
Offwidth to hands.  
(18b) Hellrazor 5.12c ★★★★★  
Good edges on a steep face  
(18c) Eric's Offwidth 5.9 ★★★★★  
Overhanging wide crack

**📍 Uncertainty Boulder**

- (17a) Bozo No No 5.11d ★  
Used as an approach to (17b). Usually aided by pulling on first bolt (5.7)  
(17b) Uncertainty Principle 5.11d ★★★★★  
The ultimate Woodson testpiece. Start on the large block at the right side of the face and head straight up the wall.  
(17c) Curtains for Certain 5.12a/b ★★★★★  
Same start as (17b) but traverse far left to a bolt and then up.  
(17d) Big Nose 5.10d ★★  
Face (TR)
